1) Write about cities:

inhabitants / tall buildings / long and wide streets / shops / businesses / public services

Cities are large areas with a lot of inhabitants. Cities have tall buildings that are homes or offices. There are a lot of long and wide streets, shops and businesses in a city. In a city you have access to many public services, for example transport of medical services.

2) Write about villages:

few / inhabitants / public services / square / church / main street / shops / businesses

Villages are small places with few inhabitants. There are not a lot of public services but there is usually a square, a church and a main street with shops and other businesses.

3) Write about the *differences* between *urban areas* and *rural areas*

Urban: large / variety / public services / transport / variety / jobs / shops / big companies / buildings / open spaces / large towns

-Urban areas: there is a large variety of public services, for example transport, such as buses, trains and metro systems. There is a large variety of jobs; some people work in shops and others in big companies. Buildings are usually closed so there are not a lot of open spaces. Some urban areas are cities or large towns.

Rural: share / services / villages / limited / transports / less / variety / jobs / farming, fishing... / spaces

Rural areas: people usually share public services, such as hospitals or schools with other villages. Public transport is usually limited to buses. There is less variety of jobs, some people work in shops, others in farming, fishing... Buildings are usually far apart so there are more open spaces. Some rural areas are villages and small towns.
