

INLAND LANDSCAPE

A **landscape** is an area of land with a particular appearance. The natural features of landscapes are called **landforms**. They can be mountains or valleys for example. Landscapes can have **natural** or **man-made features**.

It is a large, rocky area of land, that comes up high. The top of the mountain is **SUMMIT**, the sides are **SLOPES** and the bottom is **FOOT**.

It is a group of mountains.

It is a curved area of land that meets the sea.

It is a narrow area of land that sticks out into the sea.

It is low area of land between mountains or hills. Rivers often flow through valleys.

It is the high area of flat land.

CLIFF

It is a high wall of rock next to the sea.

It is an area of land that is surrounded by water.
