Since very long ago.

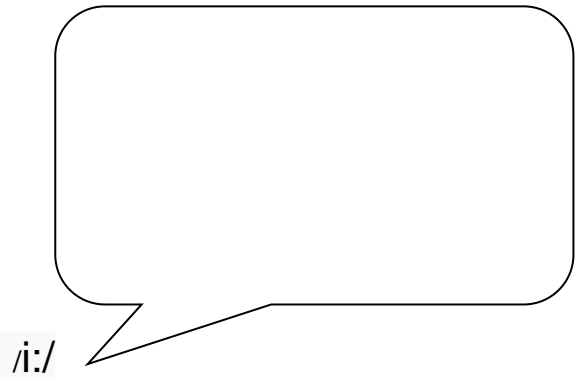
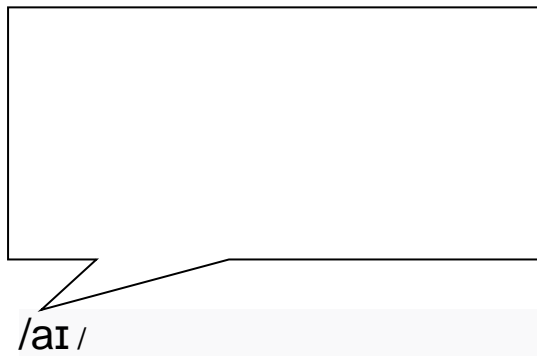
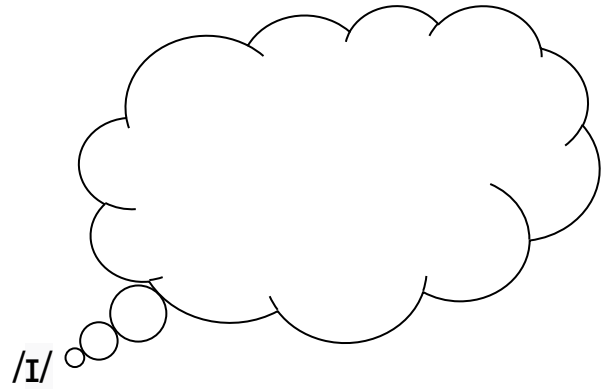
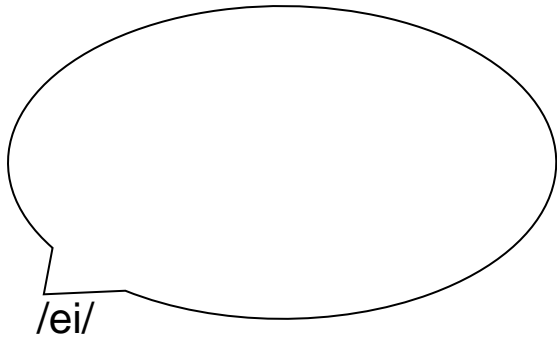
It's slightly gross, it's silly,
